

four-patch quilt

Materials

1/3 yard medium floral print fabric

1/3 yard gray print fabric

3/4 yard large floral print fabric

Note: You will need more fabric if fussy cutting your squares.

1-7/8 yards black stripe fabric

3-1/2 yards backing fabric

54" x 63" piece of batting

Yardages for 44/45"-wide fabrics.

Sew with 1/4" seam allowance.

wof = width of fabric

Cutting Instructions

From medium floral print fabric, cut:

(3) 3-1/2" x wof strips

From gray print fabric, cut:

(3) 3-1/2" x wof strips

From large floral fabric, fussy cut:

(15) 6-1/2" squares

From black stripe fabric, cut:

(14) 3-1/2" x wof strips.

From 4 strips, cut:

(24) 3-1/2" x 6-1/2" block sashing strips.

(6) 2-1/2" x wof binding strips

Making the Four-Patch Blocks

- 1 Lay out (1) 3-1/2" x wof medium floral print strip and (1) 3-1/2" x wof gray print strip as shown.

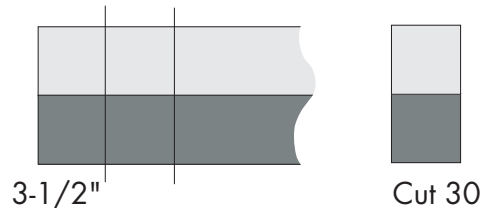


- 2 Sew the strips together along one long edge to make a strip set. Press. Make 3 strip sets.

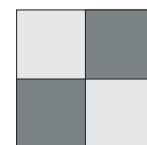
- 3 Cut the strip sets into 3-1/2"-wide segments. You will need 30.



- 4 Lay two segments right sides together with the gray print squares on the medium floral print squares. Match the center seams.



- 5 Sew the segments together and press open to make a four-patch block. Make 15 four-patch blocks.
