

The 3 x 3 Grid Blocks

Detail starts to surface in 3 x 3 grid blocks because there are nine identical squares that can be divided and sub-divided. An hour glass, flying geese, and spinning pinwheels appear as you increase the sub-division and complexity of the block. 3 x 3 grid blocks sit very well next to 6 x 6 grid blocks of the same size in a quilt setting. The seams align to give an even appearance.
