

Viewpoint

Inspired by a homespun linen dish towel, half-square triangle edges frame the striped pieced center of this table runner. The monochromatic palette unifies the fabrics and reads more as one fabric from afar.

UTILITY STYLE TIP

Depending upon your style, this runner can quietly complement a room or demand attention. Just imagine how different it would look with a large-scale print. Keep the palette within the same hue as shown in the monochromatic sample or use two or three hue complements from the color wheel to enliven the palette.

Finished Size: 16" x 70"

MATERIAL

1 yard gold solid

3/8 yard white solid

1/2 yard light stripe
(includes binding)

1/4 yard **each** of 4 assorted
gold prints (or 1 yard total)

1-1/3 yards backing

24" x 78" batting

Read through all instructions before beginning.

Sew pieces right sides together and use a 1/4" seam allowance throughout unless otherwise stated.

CUTTING

From gold solid, cut:

(4) 5" x 42" strips. From strips cut:
(12) 5" x 11-1/2" strips.

(2) 2-7/8" x 42" strips. From strips cut:
(20) 2-7/8" squares.

(3) 1-1/2" x 42" strips. From strips cut:
(9) 1-1/2" x 11-1/2" strips.

From white solid, cut:

(3) 2-7/8" x 42" strips. From strips cut:
(40) 2-7/8" squares.

(2) 2-1/2" squares.

From light stripe, cut:

(1) 2-7/8" x 42" strip. From strip cut:
(5) 2-7/8" squares.

(5) 2-1/4" x 42" strips for binding.

(1) 1-1/2" x 42" strip. From strip cut a total of:
(2) 1-1/2" x 11-1/2" strips.

From assorted gold prints, cut a total of:

(15) 2-7/8" squares

(7) 1-1/2" x 11-1/2" strips.
