

Ebb & Flow Quilt

Finished quilt size – 60-1/2" x 72"

Yardage

1-1/8 yards white fabric
1-5/8 yards olive fabric
1-1/4 yards dark taupe fabric
5/8 yard yellow-green print fabric
1/2 yard moss print fabric
1/2 yard iris print fabric
1/3 yard gold print fabric
3-3/4 yards backing fabric
68-1/2" x 80" batting

WOF = width of fabric

Cutting

From the white fabric, cut:

(5) 4" x WOF C strips
(3) 3" x WOF D strips

From the olive fabric, cut:

(2) 9-1/2" x 33-1/2" A1 strips
(1) 9-1/2" x 20" A2 strip
(2) 9-1/2" x 26-1/2" A3 strips
(1) 9-1/2" x 13-1/2" A4 strip

From dark taupe fabric, cut:

(8) 3-3/4" x 9-1/2" B1 strips
(4) 5" x WOF strips for side borders
(7) 2-1/4" x WOF strips for binding

From yellow-green print, cut:

(14) 3-3/4" x 9-1/2" B2 strips

From the moss print, cut:

(10) 3-3/4" x 9-1/2" B3 strips

From the iris print fabric, cut:

(12) 3-3/4" x 9-1/2" B4 strips

From gold print fabric, cut:

(6) 3-3/4" x 9-1/2" B5 strips

From the backing fabric, cut:

(2) WOF x 68-1/2" pieces

Sewing Instructions

1. Sew the B strips together along the long edges and in the following order to make a strip set for each row. *Note: To avoid confusion, label each strip section with its coordinating row number.*

Row 1 strip set:



B4 B1 B2 B4 B3 B2

Row 2 strip set:



B2 B4 B1 B3 B2 B5 B4 B3 B1 B2
