

San Isidro Wall Quilt

Finished size: 34-1/2" x 34-1/2"

Block sizes:
12" x 12" and 5" x 5"

Materials

5/8 yard cream fabric
3/4 yard light green fabric
1-1/8 yards burgundy fabric
1/8 yard gold fabric
1-1/8 yards backing fabric
40" x 40" batting

Quantities are for 40/44"-wide, 100% cotton fabrics. Measurements include 1/4" seam allowances. Sew with right sides together unless otherwise stated.

Cut the Fabrics

Note: Label the fabric pieces and place in stacks as you are cutting.

From cream fabric, cut:

- 4—3" x 42" strips.
From the strips, cut:
32 large diamonds for Block 1.
Refer to "Cutting Diamonds."
- 3—1" x 42" strips.
From the strips, cut:
24—1" x 5" strips for sashing and border.

From light green fabric, cut:

- 3—3-3/8" x 42" strips.
From the strips, cut:
28—3-3/8" squares. Cut each square in half diagonally for a total of 32 A triangles for Block 1.
- 2—4-3/8" x 42" strips.
From the strips, cut:
16—4-3/8" squares. Cut each square in half diagonally for a total of 32 B triangles for Block 1.

- 1—3" x 42" strip.
From the strip, cut:
12—3" F squares for sashing and border.

From burgundy fabric, cut:

- 1—2-1/8" x 42" strip.
From the strip, cut:
12—2-1/8" squares. Cut each square in half diagonally for a total of 24 C triangles for Block 2.
- 1—2-1/2" x 42" strip.
From the strip, cut:
12—2-1/2" squares. Cut each square in half diagonally for a total of 24 D triangles for Block 2.
- 7—3" x 42" strips.
From the strips, cut:
24 large diamonds for sashing. Refer to Cutting Diamonds.
- 12—3-3/8" squares. Cut each square in half diagonally for a total of 24 E triangles for sashing.
- 8—3" x 6-1/2" G rectangles for border.

From gold fabric, cut:

- 2—1-1/2" x 42" strips.
From the strips, cut:
24 small diamonds for Block 2. Refer to Cutting Diamonds.

From backing fabric, cut:


- 1—40" square

CUTTING DIAMONDS

Square up one end of the fabric strip. Align the ruler's 45-degree line with the trimmed end of the strip. Cut along the ruler's edge, creating a 45-degree angle. Place the ruler on the strip, aligning the inch-line for the desired width of the diamond with the angled edge. This will be


the same as the width of the fabric strip. Cut along the edge of the ruler to make 1 diamond.

For this quilt's large diamonds, use 3"-wide strips and measure 3" from the angled edge to cut a diamond. For the small diamonds, use a 1-1/2"-wide strip and measure 1-1/2" from the angled edge to cut a diamond.




Block 1 Assembly

1. Sew 1 light green A triangle and 1 light green B triangle to 1 cream large diamond as shown to make 1 Left Point Unit. Press seams away from diamond. Make 16 Left Point Units.

2. Referring to Step 1, make 16 Right Point Units, using the remaining light green A and B triangles and cream large diamonds.
