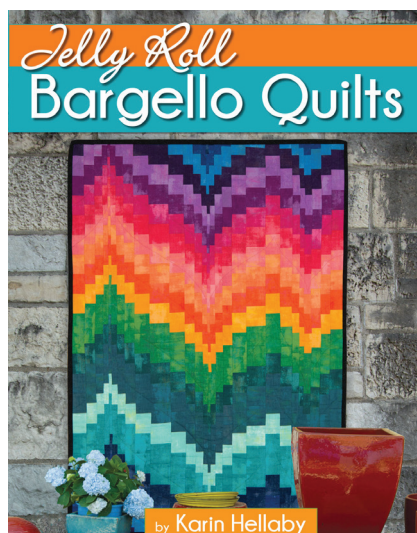


Award-winning Quilting and Patchwork Teacher Launches Jelly Roll Bargello How-to Quilt Book



East Petersburg, PA—Welcome to the world of Bargello, a style of quilt that is filled with movement and the illusion of depth thanks to the placement of the fabric's color and value. Deceptively complex-looking, Bargello quilts are easy enough for beginners, and easier still combined with precut strips of 2½" wide fabric. Bargello quilts are fun to piece and making them can be addictive!

Karin Hellaby's newest book, **Jelly Roll Bargello Quilts**, explains the process with clear instructions, easy-to-follow charts, and step-by-step

photography. Karin, a world-renowned quilting instructor, takes the reader on a journey through 19 small, quilt-in-a-day projects such as table runners, pillows, wallhangings, and lap quilts.

The Bargello piecing technique is inspired by a type of straight stitch embroidery found in the Bargello Palace in Florence, Italy. The projects in **Jelly Roll Bargello Quilts** are influenced by Karin's love for the scenic cities and countryside of Italy and like that country, they are classic and yet timeless.

Karin Hellaby is a prominent quilting and patchwork teacher who leads quilting classes around the world. She is the author of 10 patchwork and quilting books, and regularly contributes articles to quilting magazines.
